Item 3. MOTION - REQUEST FOR GOVERNMENT OF ONTARIO TO DEVELOP AND IMPLEMENT PLAN TO PHASE-OUT GAS-FIRED ELECTRICITY GENERATION AND CALL FOR CONSIDERATION OF ALTERNATIVE SOURCES OF ENERGY

The Hunt Club Community Association (HCCA) expresses its support for the motion proposed by vice-Chair Menard.

Noting that Ottawa is the only major municipality in the province in which the Council has not approved the initiative, the motion to support was approved by a majority of HCCA Board members.

Those who voted against the motion did so for two reasons. Some were of the view the province's power supply would be vulnerable to problems of unreliable and uneconomic technology. Others held that considering the urgency of addressing our changing climate the proposal was not strong enough.

HCCA asks the committee to fulfil its mandate to make recommendations to Council on environmental policy issues, including climate change, by supporting the motion.
